

Kirana jazzes up KL Golden Triangle

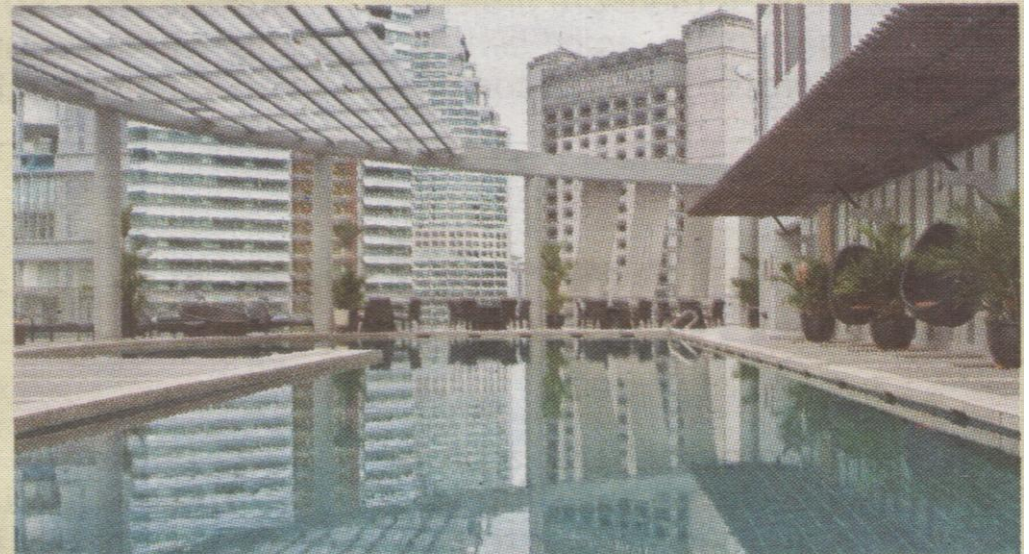
The revamp is the first of many efforts by KMC to enable Kirana to stay ahead in the highly competitive city centre real estate market.

Other enhancements include two pools with one situated on the rooftop with a view of the KL skyline, a full gymnasium, Jacuzzi, a top-notch spa, tennis court and children's playground.
